Gassers were based on production models from the 1930s to mid-1960s, which have been stripped of extraneous weight and jacked up using a truck beam axle to provide better weight distribution on acceleration. Weight reduction techniques include fiberglass body panels, stripped interiors and Plexiglas windows. Later, Gasser versions had the wheelbase moved up to 24 inches to improve rear weight distribution and therefore traction. These cars are often thought of as the predecessor to the modern funny car. Answers to the trivia:

- 1. The first V8 engine bore the title of "Antoinette".
- 2. The first patent on a V-8 engine was taken out In 1902, by Leon Levavasseur. He called it the *Antoinette*, after the young daughter of his financial backer. The Antionette found it's way into many airplanes (setting an altitude record of 3600 feet in 1910), and many boats. And yes, it also made it's way into a few cars.
- 3. In 1907 The Hewitt Motor Company built a large 5 passenger Touring Car. It came equipped with a hefty V8 engine developing about 50 horsepower, it had a bore of 4 inches and a stroke of 4 1/2 inches.
- 4. In 1932, Henry Ford introduced one of his last great personal engineering triumphs: his "en block", or one piece, V8 engine. The production was the largest commercially available V-8 to the masses. Offered as an option to an improved 4-cylinder Model "B" engine in a low priced car, this compact V8 power plant, with its down draft carburettor, enabled the 1932 Ford to outperform all other popular competitors and was conceived as years ahead of its time. The Ford Flathead V-8 is still heralded today as one of the first pioneers in 'hot rod' engines.
