And now that anticipated moment when I reveal to your eyes only, the answers to this months trivia! Wheeeee! How Fun!

OK, here we go:

- The first official U.S. wholesale auto auction held in 1938.
- It is attributed to J. M. Rawls, owner of Rawls Auto Sales in Leesville, South Carolina.
- The idea came to Mr. Rawls after attending a cattle auction. He wondered if cars could be sold the same way and acted on the idea. He returned to home and built an auction booth at his dealership, Rawls Auto Sales.
- It was 1938, followed by Manheim and Akron Auto Auctions in 1945. Ten years later, C.B. Drake, owner of the Drake Auto Auction in Decatur, Illinois, invited a group of twenty-five auto auction owners from six Midwestern states to form the first auto auction association, called the "National Auto Auction Protection Association" (NAAPA). NAAPA set up guidelines to prevent frauds in the auto auction market. In 1954, the word "Protection" was dropped from the Association's title to reflect a wider range of goals in the industry, becoming the existing National Auto Auction Association we know today.
