

Ben's 1930 Tudor Driving Instructions

Before starting the car:

- Make sure the fuse is installed on top of the starter**
- Turn the gas on (under the dash)**
- Make sure the gear shift is in neutral and the hand brake is pulled on**
- Adjust the GAV control to one full turn CCW from the full closed position**
- Push the spark advance control handle all the way up (on the left)**
- Push the throttle control handle all the way up (on the right)**

To start the car:

- Turn the ignition switch on**
- Pull the throttle advance handle half way down, keep your hand on it**
- Pull the choke control up (same control as the GAV)**
- Step on the starter**

As soon as the car starts:

- Take your foot off the starter**
- Pull the throttle handle all the way up**
- Release the choke control**
- Pull the spark advance handle down about three quarters of the way. Insert the tip of your thumb in between the handle and the bottom stop to gauge it.**
- Allow the car to warm up for about one minute**

Go for a drive:

- Put on seat belt**
- Put the gear shift in low or reverse**
- Release the hand brake**
- Drive carefully**

When done driving:

- Turn off the ignition switch**
- Pull up the hand brake**
- Put the gear shift in reverse**
- Push the spark advance handle all the way up**
- Turn off the gas**
- Pull the fuse on the starter**
