Differential Overhaul Gasket Sealer

This is the final assembly of a differential overhaul. The photo shows the right side of the banjo with the gaskets coated with Indian Head gasket sealer. Both sides of all gaskets are coated. The threaded studs are used to align the gaskets with the bolt holes.

Indian Head sealer is used in this application. It will get into the threads of the 20 banjo bolts and form an oil seal. Most of the sealer will squeeze out when the banjo bolts are torqued to 35 ft. lbs. The sealer will form a good seal and will not affect gasket thickness or the pre-load previously established.
